# HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

## FACE COVERINGS

**FACE COVERING ARE REQUIRED IN ORDER TO ENTER AND REMAIN ON PREMISES.** All persons over the age of ten (10), including employees, Members, customers, visitors, invitees and contractors who enter the YMCA must wear a face covering over their nose and mouth, such as a homemade mask, scarf, bandana, or handkerchief.

- The requirement of a face covering does not apply if covering the nose and mouth poses a significant mental or physical health risk to the individual.
- The requirement of a face covering does not apply when an individual is participating in cardio, aerobic, or aquatic activities where the wearing of a mask would pose a health risk.
- Members who do not wear a face covering will be asked to leave the premises until the face covering requirements are followed.

## SOCIAL DISTANCING

**EVEN WITH THE USE OF APPROPRIATE FACE COVERINGS, INDIVIDUALS SHOULD MAINTAIN SIX FEET OF SOCIAL DISTANCING WHENEVER POSSIBLE.**

- Members should maintain six (6) feet of separation from other individuals outside their household, to the extent feasible when inside the business YMCA.
- Members of the YMCA waiting inside or on the premises for programs or equipment must maintain six (6) feet of separation from other individuals outside their household.
